

4.-THE ROGER'S HOUSE ON SMITH ROAD

The Rogers are the owners of this charming house on Smith Road in the town of Arcadia. The house was probably built by the same person that built the Jackson and Perkins House.

STONES: The lakestones are mostly red with some white ends. Their size are $1-1\frac{1}{4}$ x $1\frac{3}{4}$ - 2 inches. A course is $2\frac{1}{2}$ inches.

JOINTS: The horizontal bead is $\frac{3}{4}$ inches high.

MORTAR: The mortar is hard, brownish, and of good texture.

LINTELS: The lintels are regulation, tooled limestone.

QUOINS: The quoins are regulation, tooled limestone.

SIDES: The stones on the sides are larger (courses are $3-3\frac{1}{2}$ in.) but very evenly laid.
