



Cobblestone home built By family's forefathers

Do you know that the George Batchellor family, of Barre is one of few farm families in Orleans County and perhaps the only one living in a Cobblestone House built by his great-great grandfather?

The original Cobblestone wing was built by Anson Sears in the late 1830's. The stones for this house were gathered from his own fields, and the lime for the mortar and plaster was burned at the site. Mr. Sears made and mixed the mor-

tar and plaster and carried it to the Cobblestone mason in a sap bucket.
