

2.- YOUNGMAN HOUSE ON THE WOLCOTT-SAVANNAH ROAD

Gordon Youngman bought this place on the Wolcott-Savannah Road in the town of Butler about three years ago. It is thought to have been a post office at one time.

STONES: On the front, the lake stones are laid in alternate bands of red and white stones of two rows each. They measure 1-2 x 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ -3 inches. A course is from 3 $\frac{1}{2}$  to 4 in.

JOINTS: The horizontal joint is a V.

MORTAR: The hard mortar has many pebbles.

QUOINS: Some of the quoins are tooled limestone.

LINTELS: The lintels are carved wood.

SIDES: All colored field stones are on the sides.
