



*In 1887, the old Cobblestone house on Nottingham road near Ram's Gulch was occupied by Damon D. Ormsby. The typical cobblestone farmhouse was constructed in 1848-9 by Adam Ainsley from stones gathered from what is now Kirk Park.*



*Today, the house is occupied by Carlyle Alexander. The walls of this Greek Revival structure are two feet thick on the outside and 18 inches on the inside. Two nearby lime kilns furnished the mortar. Thirty wagon loads of stone were required to complete it.*
