MICHAEL MARSTEINER HOUSE, LAYTON ROAD

Located on Layton Road near Zurich in the town of Lyons, this house is owned by Michael Marsteiner. It has been in the Marsteiner family for seventy years. It was built by Arthur Henry Van Der Bilt in 1831 (his initials and the date are over the front door). There are several anchors on the back and one through the middle and side. Two chimneys have been torn down.

STONES: The colors of the large lake and some field stones vary. The sizes are 3-6 x 2-3 inches. There are larger stones at the back.

JOINTS: The horizontal and vertical joints are V's.

MORTAR: The coarse mortar is rather crumbly.

QUOINS: The irregularly cut and various colored quoins are as large as 32 x 14 x 6 inches.

LINTELS: The wooden lintels are unpainted and weathered.
