

10.- THE FRIND HOUSE IN ALLOWAY

Mr. Frind is the owner of this place in Alloway. These two pieces of property were always one parcel of land. The house was built before the shop. The walls are 17 inches thick.

STONES: The field stones are of various shapes, sizes and colors. The average size is about $2\frac{1}{2}$ -6 x $2\frac{1}{2}$ inches. Because of the very prominent vertical V joint, each stone appears to be in its own panel.

JOINTS: The horizontal V is tooled. The vertical V is very strong.

MORTAR: The mortar is brownish with many small pebbles.

QUOINS: The irregular, rough cut quoins are limestone.

LINTELS: There are small wooden lintels.
