

5. — WILLIAM HOUSE HOUSE

William House owns this house on Van Winkle Road. This house has three fire places. It has a numerous number of cellar windows. Since renovation with new mortar this house seems to be in good condition.

STONES: Stones range in size $2\frac{1}{2}$ x 2 to 7 x 3 inches. Mostly lake stones, varying in color. Fairly consistent in size on each side.

JOINTS: Both horizontal and vertical joints are V's.

MORTAR: Three sides have been recently re-mortared. Mortar is two inches between rows of stone.

QUOINS: Quoins were brick, 8 x 2 x 4 inches and five to a quoin, which are usually $12 \times 16\frac{1}{2} \times 8$ inches.

LINTELS: Wooden lintels are newly painted white.
