

7.- BOREMAN-RICHMOND HOUSE ON THE OLD ROUTE 31,  
EAST OF LYONS

This house located on the old route 31 east of Lyons is owned by Susie Boreman and George Richmond. On one of the quoins is the inscription; BUILD 1834.

STONES: The stones on the east wing of the house are smooth and of all colors. They are  $2\frac{1}{2}$  - 5 x 3 inches. On the west wing the stones are mostly red and yellow and measure 3 - 5 x 2 inches.

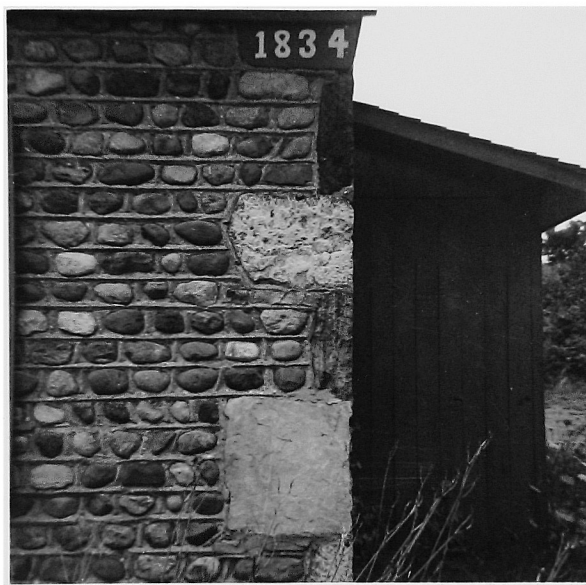
JOINTS: The horizontal V is tooled. The vertical joints are prominent.

MORTAR: The mortar is very hard but pebbly.

QUOINS: The quoins on the west wing are dash tooled. Those on the east wing are very irregular, rough cut and of all colors.

LINTELS: The lintels are wooden.
