

2. — JOHNSON HOUSE

Located on Route 31, long known as the Johnson House, and occupied for many years by Mr. Dwyer. This house, now vacant, is owned by Mr. Hoffman.

STONES: Stones are all colored field stones about $2-3 \times 1\frac{1}{2}-2$ inches.

JOINTS: The joint is a 1 inch V and the vertical joints are pyramids.

MORTAR: The mortar is gray and of medium texture.

QUOINS AND LINTELS: Regular- well cut stones of limestone were used for the quoins and lintels. Notice the columns at the entrance. The quoins were drawn from the Stone Quarry at Ontario by oxen.
