

1. - C.B. WILLIAMS HOUSE

C. B. Williams owns this house on Chapman Road in the Town of Marion.

STONES: There are about four rows per quoin. The stones are from  $3 \times 2\frac{1}{2}$  to  $1\frac{1}{2} \times 1\frac{1}{2}$  inches. The lake stones are slanted and there are many brown stones toward the top.

JOINTS: The horizontal joints are "V's" and the vertical, pyramids.

MORTAR: The mortar is in good condition but has many rather large pebbles dispersed through it.

QUOINS: The quoins are cut limestone (some are tooled) approximately  $15 \times 12 \times 15$  inches.
