

22.- THE OLD SCHOOL ON EDDY RIDGE ROAD

This old schoolhouse on Eddy Ridge Road in the town of Marion is unoccupied. In the few places among the herring-bone where the mortar has fallen out the stones remain tight.

STONES: The lakestones measure $1\frac{1}{2}$ x $1\frac{1}{4}$ inches to 2 x 2 inches.

A side is laid herring-bone fashion with red lake stones 4 x $1\frac{1}{4}$ inches falling in a vertical height of 3 inches. On the north side there are more gray and black stones on the bottom and red on the top.

JOINTS: The horizontal and vertical joints are V's.

MORTAR: The mortar is fine textured.

QUOINS: The quoins are cut limestones that vary in size.

LINTELS: The lintels are wooden.
