

3. - MARION CANNING CO., INC., MARION

This building is used as part of the Marion Canning Company.

STONES: The stones are mostly lake polished ranging in size from 2-4 x 3-8 inches. A few are cut stones and none protrudes much which definitely places the building in the early period.

JOINTS: Both the horizontal and vertical joints are V's.

MORTAR: The mortar is of medium coarseness and hardness.

QUOINS: The quoins are irregularly cut sandstones which measure 19 x 9 x 6 to 13 x $11\frac{1}{2}$ x $7\frac{1}{2}$ inches.

LINTELS: The lintels are either brick or regular rows of cobblestones.
