## VI. - IBAAC NORTHION HOUSE

Formerly a blacksmith shop, this house on Marion's North
Main Street now owned and occupied by Mrs. Nevada Viele was once
owned by Mr. Henry Allen. The corner stones are different from
those of any other house yet seen.

STONES: Red lakestones constitute the facing for the front wall. They measure  $1\frac{1}{2}$  -  $2\frac{1}{2}$  x 3 inches.

JOINTS: Pyramids were used as vertical joints and a 1 inch V as the horizantal. A course is 3 inches.

QUOINS: Rough cut limestone makes up the unusual quoins.

LINTELS: Lintels are tooled limestone.

SIDE: Larger, all colored lakestones are found at the sides.
