HISTORIC COBBLESTONE—It has been estimated that there are some 500 cobblestone buildings in Western New York. The Nunda area has two—the Link residence at 45 East street, shown in the photo, and the Beardsley residence at Oakland. These are said to be the southernmost of the cobblestones, nearly all the others being located close to Lake Ontario. The Link house was built by Quartus Barron about 1850 and the Beardsley house by Elias Fitch at about the same time. The question arises: Were the stones laboriously gathered from the Keskequa or shipped in via Genesee Valley Canal? Photo by Dick Lockwood.
