

10. - JACOB B. O'MEAL JR. GARAGE, EAST PALMYRA

This place in East Palmyra was built in 1846 and was known as District No. 7 Palmyra School. It was used until recently when a central school was started in East Palmyra. Mr. and Mrs. J. B. O'Meal bought it for \$25 for the storage of their farm implements.

STONES: The stones are red lake stones on all sides with those in front slightly smaller.

JOINTS: The horizontal and vertical joints are V's.

MORTAR: The mortar is pink.

QUOINS: The quoins are tooled limestone.

LINTELS: The lintels are also tooled limestone.
