

/.- THE HAVILAND HOUSE ON THE ROSE-WOLCOTT ROAD

This house on the Rose-Wolcott Road in the town of Rose is owned by Chester Haviland. Part of the front has been concreted over. The sides are in much better condition.

STONES: The lake stones on the front measure  $3-3\frac{1}{2} \times 1\frac{1}{2}$  inches. The field stones on the sides are much larger and more colorful.

JOINTS: The 1 to  $1\frac{1}{2}$  inch horizontal joint is a V. The vertical joints are V's and pyramids.

MORTAR: The pebbly mortar is quite weathered.

QUOINS: The quoins are irregular red or white or striped stones.

LINTELS: The lintels are wooden.
