

13.- RAYMER HOUSE ON THE ALTON-SODUS POINT ROAD

Floyd raymer owns this huge, deserted farm house on the Sodus Point-Alton Road. There is a legend that this house was the refuge for women and children who fled Sodus Point when the British landed there during the War of 1812 which resulted in one death at the Point. However, it is very unlikely that this house is that old.

STONES: The mostly lake stones are all colors and measure 2-4 x 2-3 inches. Courses are 4 inches.

JOINTS: The horizontal V is 1 inch. Vertical joints are V's and pyramids.

MORTAR: The mortar is hard, fine, and gray.

QUOINS: The quoins are regular tooled sandstone.

LINTELS: The lintels are V-cut sandstone.

BACK: Very large cut stones are at the back.
