

## 19.- SWALES HOUSE, SODUS

King Charles gave a grant of 200 acres of land on which  
(Swales)  
he built his first cobblestone house as a mason. This was his  
home and Fred Monar owns it. Part of it has been covered by  
asbestoes shingling.

STONES: The stones are of all colors and measure  $1\frac{1}{2}$ - $1\frac{3}{4}$  x 2-3  
inches.

JOINTS: The V joint is  $\frac{3}{4}$  inches high. A course is  $2\frac{1}{4}$ - $2\frac{3}{4}$  in.

MORTAR: The mortar is pebbly and weathered.

QUOINS: The quoins are rough cut red stone.

LINTELS: The lintels are vertically laid red sandstones.

SIDES: At the sides, the stones are larger and the horizontal  
larger and more uneven.

BACK: Very large cut and field stones are laid flush with the  
mortar at the back.
