

20.-ELISWORTH HOUSE, SODUS

Mr. Burns is the present owner of the Ellsworth House on the Lake Road in the town of Sodus. It was built by Swales who built several houses on the lake road. It is adjacent to his own house.

STONES: The red lake stones are rounded and they measure from $1\frac{1}{2}$ -1 $\frac{3}{4}$ x $1\frac{1}{2}$ -3 inches.

JOINTS: The horizontal V is from $\frac{1}{2}$ to $3/4$ inches high. The vertical joint is a pyramid. The courses are $2\frac{1}{2}$ inches high.

MORTAR: The reddish mortar is weathered.

QUOINS: The quoins are untooled sandstone.

LINTELS: The lintels are a row of bricks.

SIDES: White as well as red stones were used at the back.
