

32.- ROACH PLACE, SOUTH GENEVA ROAD

This place on the South Geneva Road in the town of Sodus is owned by H. Roach and tenanted by H. Farmsworth.

STONES: The lake stones are mostly red and measure $1\frac{1}{2}$ - $2\frac{1}{2}$ x $1\frac{1}{2}$ inches. The back has field stones.

JOINTS: The horizontal and vertical joints are V's.

MORTAR: The light colored mortar has been badly weathered in places.

QUOINS: The quoins are irregular, rough cut limestone.

LINTELS: The lintels are wooden.
