

3.- JAY WHITCOMB HOUSE, WALWORTH  
COR. TOWN LINE ROAD and SMITH HILL ROAD

Owned by Jay Whitcomb for the past three years this house on the corner of Town Line and Smith Hill Roads just in the township of Walworth, was once the Hal Center School House.

STONES: The red, white, and black stones including many of igneous origin measure  $1\frac{1}{2}$  - 2 x 2 - 3 inches.

JOINTS: The V horizontal joint is 1 inch high and the vertical joints are pyramids. A course is 3 inches, four per quoin.

MORTAR: The red mortar is fine in texture.

QUOINS: Quoins are of the regular, tooled limestone type.

BACK : Larger lake stones are at the back but all four sides are faced with lake stones.
