

/, - THE EDDY OR HARDEN PLACE ON EDDY ROAD

This house on Eddy Road in the town of Williamson has been in the Eddy family for four generations. It is believed that Mr. Harden bought it in 1870. The present owner is a great grand-daughter of C. Eddy who bought it of Mr. Harden. It is exquisitely furnished with many large and small oriental rugs.

STONES: The small lake stones in front measure $2\frac{1}{2}$ x $1\frac{1}{2}$ inches.

JOINTS: The horizontal joints are V's and the vertical joints are pyramids.

MORTAR: The mortar is fine textured and light colored.

QUOINS: The quoins are evenly cut, untooled limestone.

LINTELS: The lintels are vertically laid limestones.
