

14.- THE MEEKER PLACE

Located on the West Town Line Road in the town of Williamson this house occupied by the Meekers is just down the road from the Jobse Place.

STONES: Red lake stones which measure $1\frac{1}{2}$ - $1\frac{1}{4}$ x $1\frac{1}{2}$ - $2\frac{1}{2}$ are at the front.

JOINTS: The $\frac{3}{4}$ inch horizontal joint is a V and the vertical joints are pyramids. A course is $2\frac{1}{2}$ inches.

MORTAR: The brownish mortar is pebbly.

QUOINS and LINTELS: The quoins and lintels are tooled limestone.

SIDE: The lake stones are all colors on the sides.
