


/6.-PATTESICT HOUSE ON THE EAST WILLIAMSON RD.

Mr. Pattesict owns this house on the East Williamson Road north of East Williamson. The builders--the Hance brothers went broke during the construction. They had to sell it after which the second part was added.

STONES: The red lake stones are  $1\frac{1}{2}$ -2 x  $1\frac{1}{2}$  inches.

Courses are  $2\frac{1}{2}$  inches high.

JOINTS: The horizontal joint is rather unusual. It is neither a true V or bead. It is neither pointed at the end. The shape has not been clouded by weathering. It is shaped thus; 

The vertical joints are V's and pyramids.

MORTAR: The mortar is red and fine textured.

QUOINS and LINTELS: The quoins and lintels are regular, tooled limestone.
