

4 - THE PRATT HOMESTEAD OR WENDALE HOUSE ON EDDY RIDGE

This house on the Eddy Ridge Road in the town of Williamson is variously known as the Pratt Homestead and the Wendale Farm House. There used to be a log cabin where the wooden part now stands. They lived here while the cobblestone part was built between 1840 and 1842.

STONES: The stones, mostly lake, measure 1-3 x 1½-2½ inches.

JOINTS: The horizontal and vertical joints are V's.

MORTAR: The mortar is hard, light colored, and fine textured.

QUOINS: The quoins are irregular cut limestone.

LINTELS: The lintels are vertically laid limestones.
