Vol I No. 27 It was Spring in 1957 when George Becker, General Chairman of the Medina Hospital's public subscription drive, was lifted by a mechanical hoist to the top of a giant thermometer on Main Street in Medina to record the last successful effort. Public giving had raised \$362,390 in pledges, half the money needed for the \$700,000 expansion project. Altogether, more than \$715,855 was received by the building committee, From surplus hospital funds came \$61,404. An investment fund netted \$327,000 and a Ford Foundation Grant of \$20,600 was also received. The "new" Medina Memorial Hospital enlargement was finished in 1959 with dedicatory ceremonies and the sealing of the cornerstone.
