Model airplane afloat

Our unusual picture shown here was taken on Sept. 2, 1909, during the great parade which was held for the Gaines Centennial.

Just six years prior to this in 1903, Wilbur and Orville Wright had made their successful flight at Kittyhawk. This must have been on the minds of forward-looking Americans, including Marc Cole of Eagle Harbor, who concocted and constructed this unique float pulled by a team of horses.

The horses are going one way and the airplane is headed in the opposite direction as we note from the position of the propeller.

The sign on the side of the float denotes the name of the airplane as "The Eagle."

This photo was taken somewhere along Ridge Road between Gaines and Childs.

People along its parade route got to see it twice. When the parade got to its destination, the



exhibitors turned around and followed the same route back to where they had commenced.

As an editorial comment, let me say I think that's a good idea that could easily be capitalized upon today as parade organizers plot their routes for various occasions.
