The man with the wheelbarrow was Palmer Lyon pushing himself. The man playing cards who is pointing a gun at himself was George Ball. Both of these deceptions were created in the studio of Albion photographer R. P. Stillman around 1900. The other picture, a post card, is James Johnstone of Medina taken in 1918. An inscription says in part "Feeling 5 times as well as when I left home." With simple equipment and an abundance of creative imagination photographers of yesteryear have certainly left for us their sense of humor.
