## Vanished Orleans:

## The S.A. Cook cottage

Now here was an extravaganza! This stick cottage was built around 1890 on Lakeside Bluff in the town of Carlton by S.A. Cook of Medina. The skeleton aspects of balloon-style framing were used as decorative architectural design elements.

The stick style was particularly popular for resort buildings during the 1880s and 1890s. The Cook cottage

boasted a whimsical four-story open tower or gazebo which was only partly attached to the main body of the structure.

In the winter of 1926, a fire of suspicious origin destroyed this unique piece of American architecture. The Carlton fire truck housed only a mile away in Kuckville could not be started. By the time firemen could get to Lakeside Bluff with their apparatus it was too late.
