Tragedy struck with train crash in Carlton in 1883

This picture was taken
following the train wreck at
Carlton (Ashwood) on July
27, 1883.



A freight car was blown
off a siding onto the main
track when an excursion
train running to the
Thousand Islands hit it at
9:48 p.m.

The two heavy engines
were both overturned and heavy steel sleeping cars on the rear of the train crushed
the light weight wooden passenger cars ahead.
As a result 17 people were killed and 25 were injured.
Our picture shows a number of curiosity seekers looking over the wreckage the
next day.
