This exceptionally outstanding Colonial Revival Style residence once graced South Main Street in Albion.

It was built in 1906 for Albert C. Burrows and his family. He was a prominent attorney

and somewhat wealthy as his home would portray.

In later years the home was owned by Charles Martina who sold it in 1967. It was then razed along with the Clarke house next door when Bells Supermarket was built on the site.

Currently this location is used by KFC.
