Vanished Orleans — Clarendon ME Church

On Feb. 28, 1848, the Methodist Episcopal Church and Society of Clarendon was incorporated. In 1851 they erected the imposing Greek Revival building pictured here. It was located facing south on the cor-

ner of Church Street and Byron-Holley Road.

The Italianate window sash were added in the early 1870s. In 1892 a disastrous fire destroyed the church and several other buildings in the neighborhood. A new church was built on the same site, and dedicated in 1893. It now serves as a residence.
